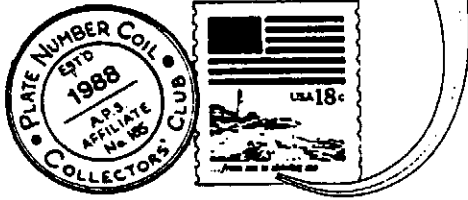

Double Die Cut Flag Found

A Florida collector has found a most unusual cutting error on a roll of the self adhesive Flag Over the Porch coil with cylinder combination #88888. This is not just another die cut shift, but a genuine double application of the cutting mats.

Victor Westerling purchased the roll in a Florida post office and discovered that it is not only die cut normally between stamps, but is die cut through the middle of all 100 stamps. This has the effect of creating 200 half stamps.

Two illustrations appear here because it was not possible to make both the normal cuts and the extra cuts appear in one picture. The small strip below shows the normal cuts to have a teeth count of L11XR10. It also shows the top and bottom straight lines of the interior cuts, but not the serpentine lines.

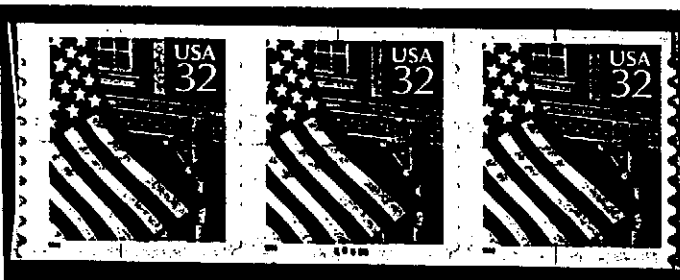
The single stamp illustration has the stamp slightly split apart to show an interior teeth count of L10XR10. The left side faintly shows the normal cut.

The fact that the two cuts are different sizes gives us a clue as to what probably happened. The BEP's Andreotti gravure press is equipped with die cutting mats that are used only in an emergency. Normally all die cutting is done on the processing machines.

My theory is that during printing someone accidentally engage the press mats, and some or all of the press roll was cut down the middle of the stamps. No effort was made to properly align the point of incision, and the error cuts went undetected. This produced the 10X10 size.

When the press roll went to processing, it was cut, sliced, rolled and packaged normally. This cutting made the "between stamps" 11X10 size.

The end result appears to be a real production error. There must be at least 19 other rolls out there, unless they were sold, then returned and destroyed. A natural bisect isn't of much practical use to a non-collector.



Test strip nets club \$330 in auction

The club's profit from the recent auction was boosted \$330 by the price realized for Lot 555, a no number strip of six of a linerless test coil that was an anonymous donation.

The strip was offered as three pairs and as a strip, with the method bringing the highest amount dictating the method of sale. The strip was illustrated on the front page of the June 1, 1997 issue of *Coil Line*.

Auctioneer Joe Sedivy reports 334 of the 555 lots offered were sold. The date for the next auction has not been announced.

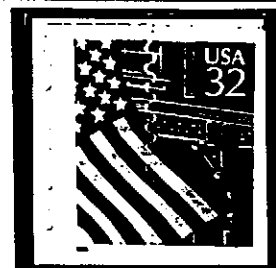

PNC3 Web Site Report

Since the inception of the idea for a PNC3 web site last year, many people have worked long and hard to bring the idea to fruition. Even before the formal approval of the PNC3 web site by the officers at the annual meeting last August, plans were being formulated, information was being gathered and ideas solicited from the membership.

We now have a web site online with a host of material and more being added as time permits.

The web site is located at "<http://www.geocities.com/Heartland/Hills/6283>." The effort so far has not invaded the treasury and does not appear that it will do so in the near future. Our host server, Geocities, has just raised the amount of free space available to us by a third. The web site officially went online the beginning of September, 1997 with a very preliminary structure, consisting of mostly links to other sites. The first order of business was to post some information about our group and provide an application form. According to reports forwarded to me, we have already received several applications from those reading about us through the web site.

Following the initial postings, a copy of the PNC3 By-laws and Code of Ethics was posted. The next project was a listing of all US Philatelic outlets. I had been gathering this information for several years, in cooperation with several other collectors, and felt that this type of data would be a good vehicle to draw people to our site. I had set a deadline for myself of the first of the new year to get the data transferred to the html format (computer language for web sites). There was no easy way, as far as I could tell, to go from a database to the format I needed, so I virtually had to retype all the data. In the process, as I put more and more states online, I received additional help from many people to flesh out the information that I already had.

I hope that we can provide a true service to the collecting community by providing a comprehensive resource about the USPS Philatelic Outlets that is not available from the Postal Service. Your help is solicited in adding to the available information and keeping it updated.

After beating my self imposed deadline by a hair, I started on the next project, which was to include a listing of all Plate Number Coils. So far, I have listed the Flag Series, the Transportation coils, the Contingency stamps and will soon be working on the Miscellaneous issues. My goal was to immediately list the basic stamps and then go back and add varieties. I'm well on the way.

There are still many features that I plan to include on the web site. One of these deals with our auctions. I'm looking for some feedback on how to set up the auction online so that all of the data will not have to be retyped. I'm in the process of checking out other auction sites on the web to see how they handle their auctions.

There are several philatelic offices, known to me, that publish a list of what they have in stock. As time permits, I'll add the coil material from those lists.

The jury is still out on how we will handle dealer ads on the site, but I've had a couple of inquiries from dealers who are eager to use our site to showcase their material.

I'm certainly not out of ideas for content, and over the course of the coming year, you'll see a wealth of material added to the site.

Just after the start of the new year, I added a counter which gives a rundown on how many people log on to the 'home' page (our main page). This only tallies those who enter the site through the home page and does not count those who access one of the other pages directly.

The current count, which can be checked by clicking the small box at the bottom right of the home page, shows that an average of almost 10 people a day are visiting the site through the home page.

There are many avenues available for promoting our web site, including getting it listed on search engines, getting links from other sites, joining a web ring and hard copy promotion. For those unfamiliar with the jargon above, be assured that I will use all of these resources to promote our web site.

I welcome any comments, suggestions and/or criticisms that you might have concerning the web site. Please direct them to me by email or 'snail mail'. I sincerely hope that you enjoy our web site and can benefit from the material contained therein.

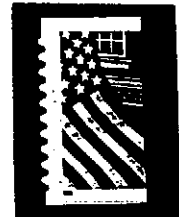

- Type a - L12VP/R12PV
- Type b - L11VV/R12PP
- Type c - L11PP/R10VV
- Type d - L10PV/R10VP
- Type e - L10VV/R11PP



In the type designation, P and V are "peak" and "valley". In the illustration above the serpentine cut starts with a peak at the top and ends with a valley at the bottom. That is type "d" which is L10/R10.

Type "e" is an inverted type "c" and is known on only two numbers. See the bold print in the table below.

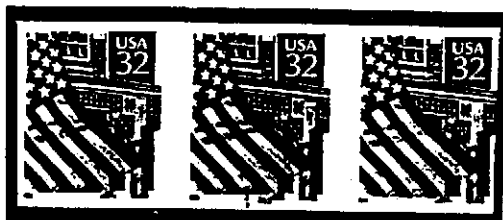

There are no new numbers this month, but one dealer is offering Yellow Rose #6666 for the first time.

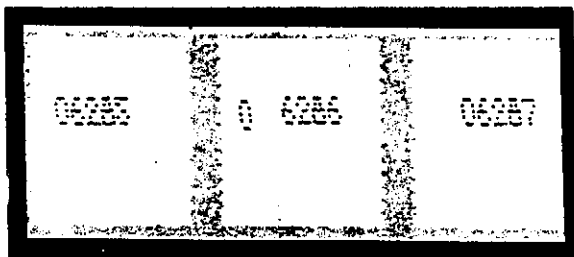
That Blank Space

About one third of the members received a copy of *Coil Line* last month with a picture missing on the Snippets page. During automated copying the machine "ate" the illustration under the item about the shifted 3's on Flag #33333. For the benefit of those who got a bad copy, the picture is repeated below. The printer heard from me.



Back Number Shift

Alan Malakoff found this unusual shift of only one digit out of five on an Avery Mountain SA coil strip. The lead zero has shifted to the left on the back of the 4L stamp of cylinder combination V333342.



Monterey Park VDC Machine Gone

Richard Beecher reports the machine that dispensed variable denomination coils in the Monterey Park post office has been removed. It was one of two such machines in the southern California area. No explanation was available, but the stamps may not have been very popular with the public.

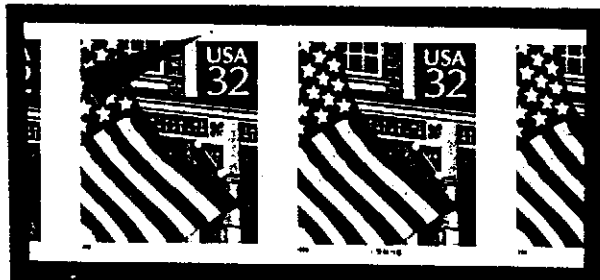
Flag Misalignments Keep Coming

Another Flag coil with the cylinder numbers badly misaligned has been found by a member who wishes to remain anonymous. Dick Koenig reported the find. As illustrated below, the dark blue 6 on #66666 has dropped down well below the rest of the digits. Dick says the finder searched the western PA area where it was discovered but found no other rolls. It has been named the "Deep Six".



Brown "Top Dot" CPV

The last two months we gave space to the Brown Date Dot constant plate variety on SA Flag coils and indicated it could exist on eight different cylinder combinations. Now Sherwood Day has found a similar situation where a brown dot is located in the top margin above the "U" of USA on the 2L stamp. Sherwood provided examples of the dot on #87888, #89878 and #89888. This dot could be present on all eight combinations that used the dark brown "8" cylinder. Here's another challenge. Find all eight strips. What to look for is shown below.



Old Ones Revisited

More old Flag number combinations have been added to the list of those being found again. Number 89899 is still not among them. Here's the complete list.

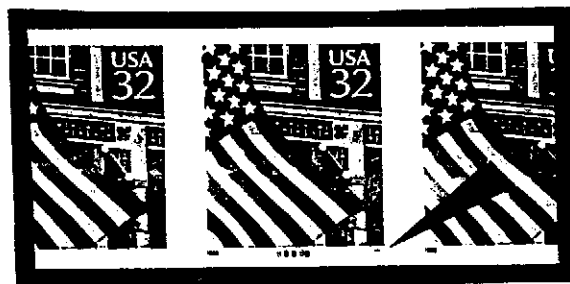

No less than three members submitted examples of a red dash under the lower right corner of the design of the numbered stamp (1L) on #88888 and #89888. Bob Rowe, Doug Iams and David Kemp each found at least one example. One other combination used that red "8" cylinder, so look for #87888 with this mark too.

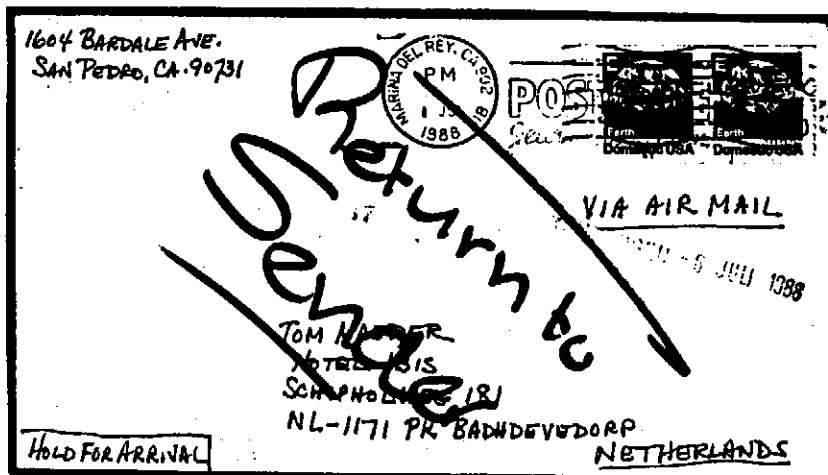

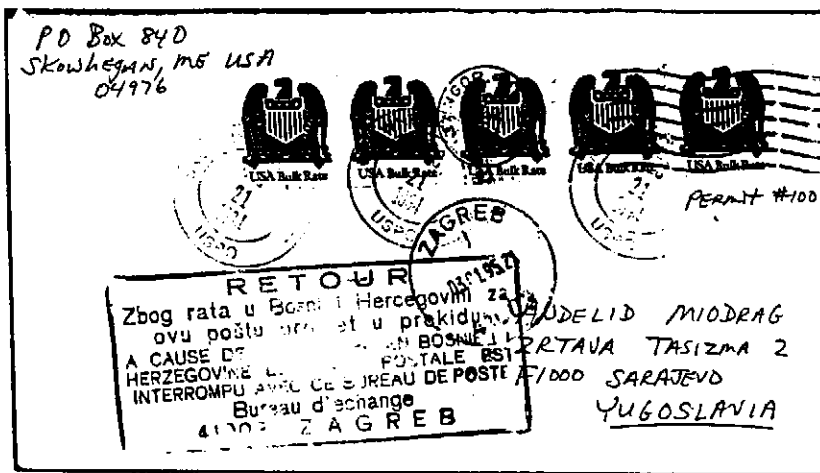

INCIDENCE REPORT NARRATIVE

This month's chart brings to a close the 1997 Commercial Covers reports. All Coil Line reports are included plus 3900 PNC covers from MD and CA sources.

Some reports have contained tidbits of information which pertain to the numbers therein. Kemp reports the YR issue appears unpopular and many P.O.s don't stock them. As I mentioned in an earlier report, FOP coils are shipped to P.O.s when coils are ordered unless YR is specified. As most still use older order forms, the YR number is absent. Distribution centers have the coils but they ship what is ordered unless it's necessary to substitute. There was no automatic distribution of YR coils and many clerks don't bother to read the P.O. publications. The YR coils will become more prominent as FOP stocks are depleted. If your local outlet doesn't have any, tell them to order 77569. The numbers seem to be relatively well distributed with no glaring absences in, nor shortages of, numbers. They all seem to be where you find them with new numbers showing up with new orders. The 2233 first appeared to be the difficult item but recent finds on the East Coast will fatten the supply.

In regard to Beecher's note on the high premium FOP numbers, how soon and how bad do you want them? If completeness is your bag, then grab when you can. I've suffered both ways; waiting for prices to go down with new finds-and losing, and buying high with new finds appearing soon thereafter-and losing! But I've had the enjoyment of seeing all the new strips in residence and moved on to other enjoyable aspects. To each his own and the probability of prediction without a crystal ball or data sheets (in which reliability is suspect) is as good for one as the other.

The chart shows movement on all numbers this time - even on the tough ones. Only the large roll Vlllll showed no gain along with that '97 lllll FOP, which isn't used either!

As we approach the next rate-change, the FOP and YR issues will be the main stuff we'll see and they will start to dwindle as new issues are produced. The "H" stamp has been in the news frequently with early usages and subsequent investigations. And we know the coil hoppers weren't cleaned out successfully either. What finds!

Plans for the discontinuation of FOP numbers is being held in abeyance for the time being as new quantities of the tough numbers are being reported. We'll continue to keep tabs on their activity until a definite product use decline is indicated by lack of substantial reports.

Thanks to those regular reporters. They keep our membership enlightened on the numbers of the issues and provide a basis for intelligent expenditures. All of you are appreciated. Also appreciated are reports of mixture sorts and accumulations which round out the issue's usage across the country, like Jeff Fiszbein's 55# mix sort (included in this issue).

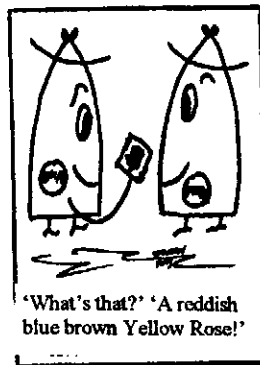
