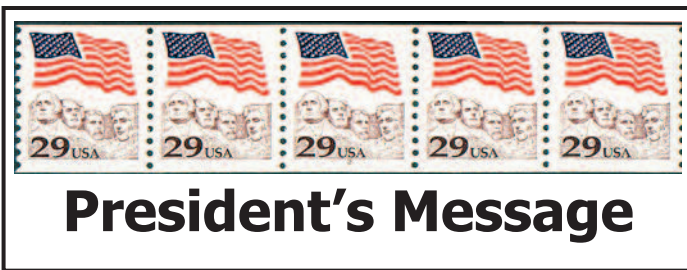

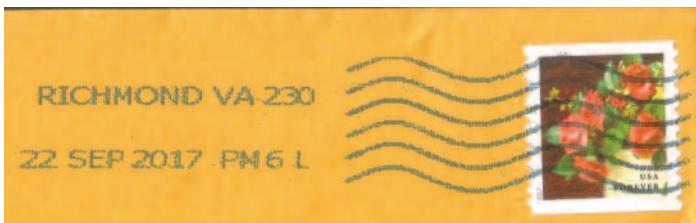

This is to contrast them with “patriotic” design choices, currently 2016’s forever “Patriotic Spiral.” The USPS has not traditionally maintained stocks of both choices in large-roll formats.

The *Flowers from the Garden* issue follows the Ferns coils, first issued in 2014, as the pretty design. What reader will report the first plate-numbered example on cover?

Flowers Bloom on the Mail

It didn’t take long for the new “pretty” design choice in affixer rolls at the forever first-class rate to appear on mail.

The U.S. Postal Service issued the *Flowers from the Garden* set of four designs on August 16, 2017. The available formats include rolls of 3,000, rolls of 10,000 and double-sided panes of 20 (convertible booklets). All are self-adhesive.

I found the business-to-business cover shown here discarded in a post office trash can on September 30, postmarked on September 22.

The USPS informally calls the issue the “pretty

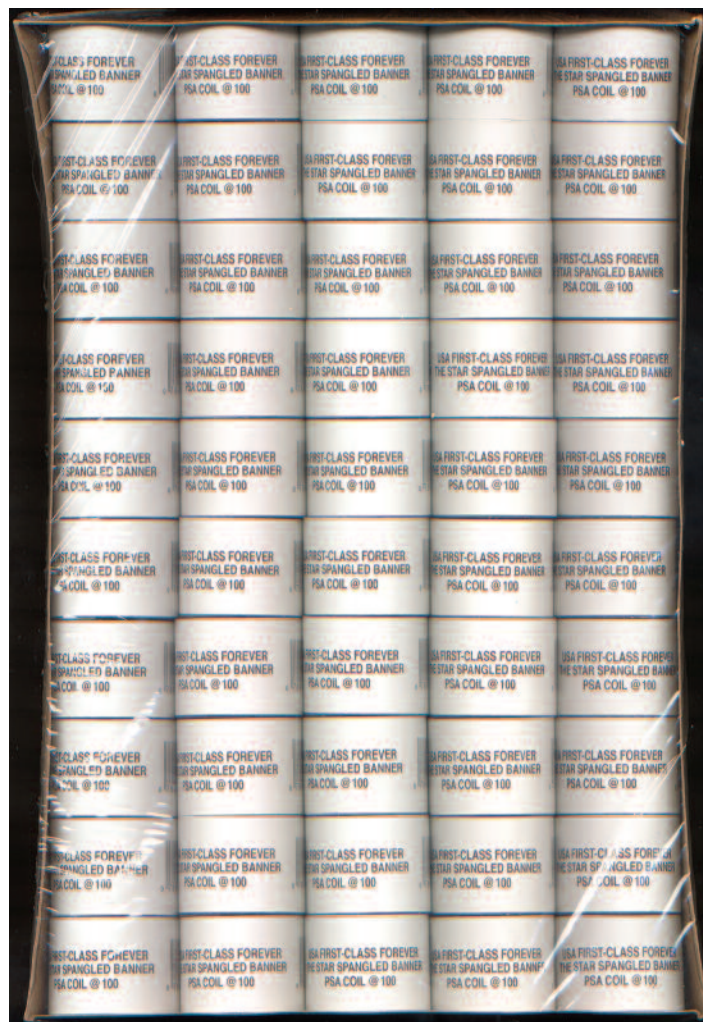

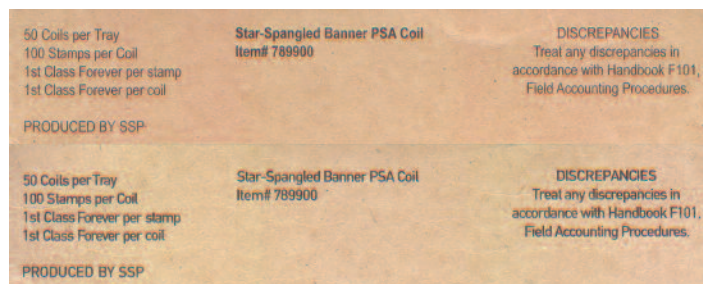
Fake Tray for the Star-Spangled Banner SSP

I recently came across someone on eBay selling 50 rolls of the Star-Spangled Banner. To my surprise, the rolls arrived in a sealed tray, just like you would buy in the post office.



The first thing I noticed was that the rolls were not attached, which is how all the fake rolls I have found over the past year have been. When looking at the sealed tray, this is obvious because there is a lot of black showing around the edges of the rolls. You wouldn't see this if these rolls were actually printed by Sennett Security Products.



The tray has printing on both ends similar to a normal tray (the normal tray is on top in the picture). However, on the fake, all of the type is in a bold font. "Star-Spangled Banner PSA Coil/Item# 789900" are the only things that are bold on the real version. The alignment is very good, but the font is obviously different from the original.

I only have an end label, not the full tray for the real version, so if anyone has a real one that I can borrow for a side-by-side comparison, it would be appreciated.

PNC³ SESCOAL Report

We had a wonderful time at the PNC³ meeting at the SESCOAL stamp show on Saturday, October 14. The meeting was hosted by Dan Forgues and myself. The show was at a new location this year, the Ontario Convention Center in Ontario, California, and it was a modern, spacious facility. It looked like attendance was way up from the prior shows, which were held near Los Angeles International Airport at an aging venue. In attendance at the club meeting were 13 PNC³ members and guests.

We kicked off the meeting by discussing the new issues that have been coming out in recent months, talked about the sawtooth separator cuts that have shown up on some of the new Forever coils, discussed the fact that at least two new PNCs have come out with "B" plate number prefixes but with the same Scott catalog number as their "S" prefix counterparts, and explained about the limited distribution of the Father Ted Herburgh oversize vertical format coil. This led to a number of questions and there was a great dialog about all these new trends.

Dan Forgues presented his brand new slide show on "Look Alike PNCs." He showed identical-looking used PNC singles, side-by-side, then explained why one was different from the other and why there was such a divergence in pricing between the stamps. It was a thought-provoking presentation and Dan fielded multiple questions from those present.

Dan also showed some interesting PNC checklists that have been prepared by Hans van Gils in The Netherlands. Hans has a checklist for each major category of stamp and each provides valuable information that will benefit collectors.

We were fortunate to get 15 minutes of time from John Hotchner, former APS President, Citizens Stamp Advi-

sory Committee member, *Linn's Stamp News* U.S. Stamp Notes columnist and PNC³ member. John led a discussion about the various counterfeit stamps that have been showing up in recent years. He stated he would like to have any additional information that can be provided by club members concerning their finds on eBay or in mixtures of counterfeit stamps. He mentioned several PNC³ club members who have been helping him already in this quest and it was amazing what knowledge resides in our club on this topic. We were extremely grateful to John for taking time out of his busy show schedule to drop by.

Dan provided side-by-side examples of the Mt. Rushmore Toledo brown stamps vs. regular Rushmore stamps to those who didn't get copies earlier this year at the ORCOEXPO meeting. There were a number of comments about how helpful these examples will be in distinguishing Toledo browns from the regular color maroonish-brown stamps.

At the end of the meeting everyone present took home a nice door prize and there was some vigorous trading amongst the members. Many thanks to club member/dealer Dave Cobb for providing some very nice door prizes.

John announced that we will try to have the next Southern California PNC³ meeting at ORCOEXPO in January. Keep an eye on future issues of *Coil Line* for more information.

John Greenwood's Error Corner

This month's imperf Cottrell issue being discussed is the 10.9¢ precancel Hansom Cab (Scott #1904b). Although the Hansom Cab production included rolls with plate number combinations of #1 and #2 and #3 and #4, no #3 or #4 were found imperf.



During the time the Hansom Cab was current, collecting gap positions of Cottrell issues was very popular. These imperfs were from the very common line gap position.

While trying to find unusual coils at a local mass mailer, a very nice owner allowed me to go through a drawer he had of scraps of stamps from previous runs. In the drawer were stamps that had previously jammed his machines.



In this tangle of coil stamps I found old 10.9¢ coil stamps that included an imperf piece that was, I believe, partially perforated by his mailing equipment's pins. It is mis-cut and torn in several places due to its mishandling. Because of machine or human handling, much of the found imperf material is damaged. Imperf strips of the 10.9¢ catalogue at \$1,100 each. This seems high.
