Short Buggy Whip on 4.9-Cent Precancel # 6

In recent weeks it has come to my attention that there is a constant plate variety (CPV) on the 4.9-cent precancel stamp, Scott 2124a, with plate #6. I'm going to call it a "short buggy whip." As you probably know, the "buggy whip" variety has been known for many years on both 2124 and 2124a with plate #4. Figure 1 is an example.

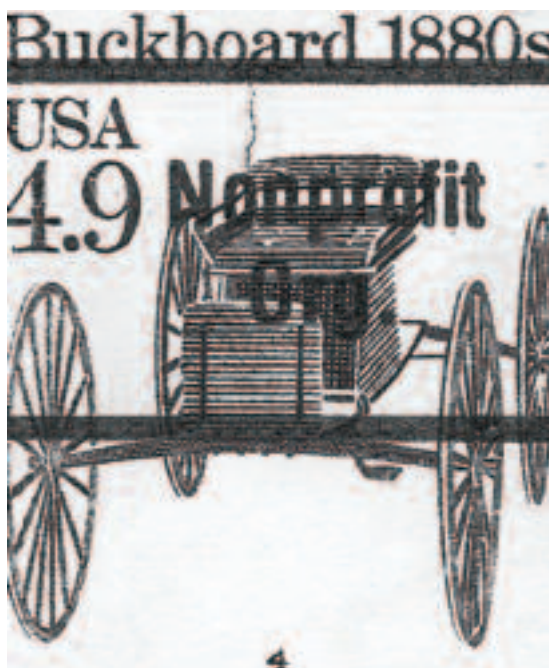

Sometimes this variety is "short" (from earlier in the press run) and sometimes it is "long" (from later in the press run), referred to as "short buggy whip" and "long buggy whip." The one illustrated here is the "long buggy whip."

Until now, I had not heard of a "short buggy whip" on the plate #6 stamp. I checked all the standard references and floated an email out to a number of members who know about these things and none of them had heard of this CPV on plate #6. To verify its existence, I obtained seven different plate number strips of this anomaly, and all had the same plate crack. See Figure 2, as well as a closer view in Figure 3.

Note that this "short buggy

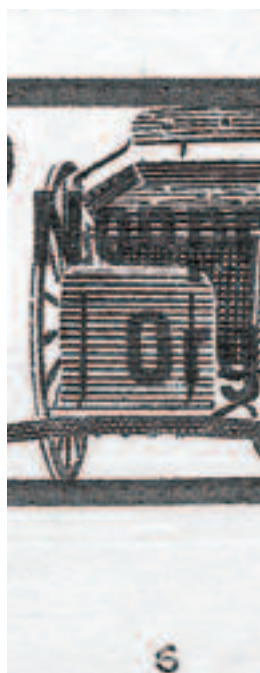

whip" on plate #6 differs from the one on plate #4, as would be expected, since they're from different printing plates. The one on plate #6 is about 1 mm to the right of the position where it occurs on #4. It's also less pronounced than a typical example on plate #4, indicating that the

crack in the printing plate is not as wide. Nevertheless, it is absolutely a CPV.

I have not seen this anomaly on 2124, the non-precanceled version of this stamp. Does anyone in the club have an example of this CPV on 2124?

Newly Revised Catalog Chapters

Two newly revised chapters of the PNC³ *Catalog of Plate Number Coils* are being released at the end of November. Both are important updates to chapters that members will find useful, especially newer members who may not have previously added them to their catalog holdings.

The first is a revised *Illustrated Glossary* of terms found in PNC³ publications. Next is an updated Precancel Gaps Values List, featuring recently discovered precancel gaps and pricing estimates for the rarities among them. There is a price list and order form on the wrapper in this issue. As always, print quantities are based on orders received; in this case, by the end of November.

The *Illustrated Glossary* contains approximately 180 terms, found on 29 pages of three-hole punched 8 ½ X 11 white stock. This completely revised edition adds new terms and features for new printing, packaging and collecting terms encountered since the previous edition was published. Illustrations in this new edition are embedded in the text so readers can more easily view the items described. Illustrations are in full color and have arrows and circles pointing to the features described.

The *Precancel Gaps Values List* offers information on precancel gaps discovered since the previous edition was published. In some cases, these gaps are considered rare and would carry high prices if they were to be listed by specialist dealers. Due to a lack of data, estimates are offered for such gaps. Also included on the order form are prices for reprints of the early *New Issues Chapters* beginning with issues of 2002, the first year the catalog was published. *New Issues Chapters* were printed in limited quantities based on pre-orders and have been reprinted (again in limited quantities) to give newer members an opportunity to own them. Availability is limited to quantities on hand.

Missing Punctuation Error



Jim Carmack recently sent in a scan of a 4-cent Stagecoach precanceled PS5 strip, Scott #1898Ab, with plate number 3. What's interesting about this strip is the fact that the period is missing after the word "Org" in the precancel on the stamp at 3L. (See close-up.)

Jim wondered if any other member had seen this same anomaly in the 3L position or if this is a new find. John Himes checked his stock book and he did find a copy there with this same anomaly, so it's not unique, but it does ap-



pear to be fairly rare. Has anyone else found a copy with this same anomaly?

Coil Line Procedures and Deadlines

Deadline

Deadline for the receipt of articles, letters, advertising and news is the first of the month preceding the month of publication. For example, we need everything for the November issue by October 1, everything for the December issue by November 1, everything for the January issue by December 1 and so on.

The preferred method of receiving copy is via an email attachment. Please send as an MS Word document. We also welcome compact discs (CDs). Hard copy is acceptable but must be rekeyed so electronic submission is preferred.

All submissions are subject to editing for length, clarity and content. Every effort is made to retain the facts without changing the meaning or thrust of the article.

Illustrations

The most effective way to transmit illustrations is electronically. They should be TIFF or JPEG. Anything that needs enlarged, for example plate numbers or microprinting, should be scanned at 2400 dpi; covers and items running actual size should be submitted at 300 dpi. They can be sent on CD and we can retrieve copy and illustrations from electronic copy if provided the correct routing. Do not embed illustrations in a Microsoft Word document, but attach separately to an email. Word sets parameters not recognized by Adobe Photoshop, my photo program, and I am unable to produce the best quality illustrations from Word.

SESCAL Meeting Report

On Saturday, October 5, 14 PNC³ members and guests met for a two-hour get-together at the SESCAL stamp show in Ontario, California. The gathering was hosted by John Himes and Dan Forgues. Just like last year, the meeting room and accommodations in the Ontario Convention Center were absolutely outstanding. The meeting was kicked off with introductions among the attendees. Listening to their list of philatelic interests, it's amazing what our members collect besides PNCs!

The first topic of discussion was the very light issuance of new coils since our last meeting at ORCOEXPO in January. This was followed by a discussion about the recent discovery that the 2019 *Scott U.S. Specialized Catalogue* mispriced three of the 2915A Flag Over Porch stamps. The result is that some sellers on eBay are charging exorbitant prices for the common versions of these three strips. John reported that the Scott editors have been very willing to work with our club to correct these issues, but it's too late for the 2020 Catalogue. Everyone was warned to use the PNC³ Values List when pricing Scott 2915A until the 2021 catalogue is issued with the appropriate corrections.

Dan kicked off the main presentation, titled "Constant Plate Varieties (CPVs) on PNCs." He showed high-resolution scans of a number of CPVs, such as the "buggy whip" #4 and the newly discovered "buggy whip" #6 on Scott 2124 and 2124a. This sparked a lively discussion among the members and guests, and everyone walked away with a better understanding of what constitutes a CPV.

Member Dr. John Greenwood talked about the new Scott errors catalog that prices a number of PNC errors such as imperforate or color missing varieties. John was one of the main contributors to the listing and pricing of these error stamps, and it was amazing to listen to him speak about how the catalog was pulled together. For those looking to collect these error varieties, this catalog is pretty much the bible for that field of collecting.

John and Dan passed around some other important reference works for the attendees to peruse, such as Rob Washburn's great book on purple machine cancels. The meeting finished off with a lively Q&A session and door prizes for everyone in attendance.

The meeting was adjourned to a time of buying, selling and trading among the attendees. John announced that we will get together again at the ORCOEXPO show in January.
