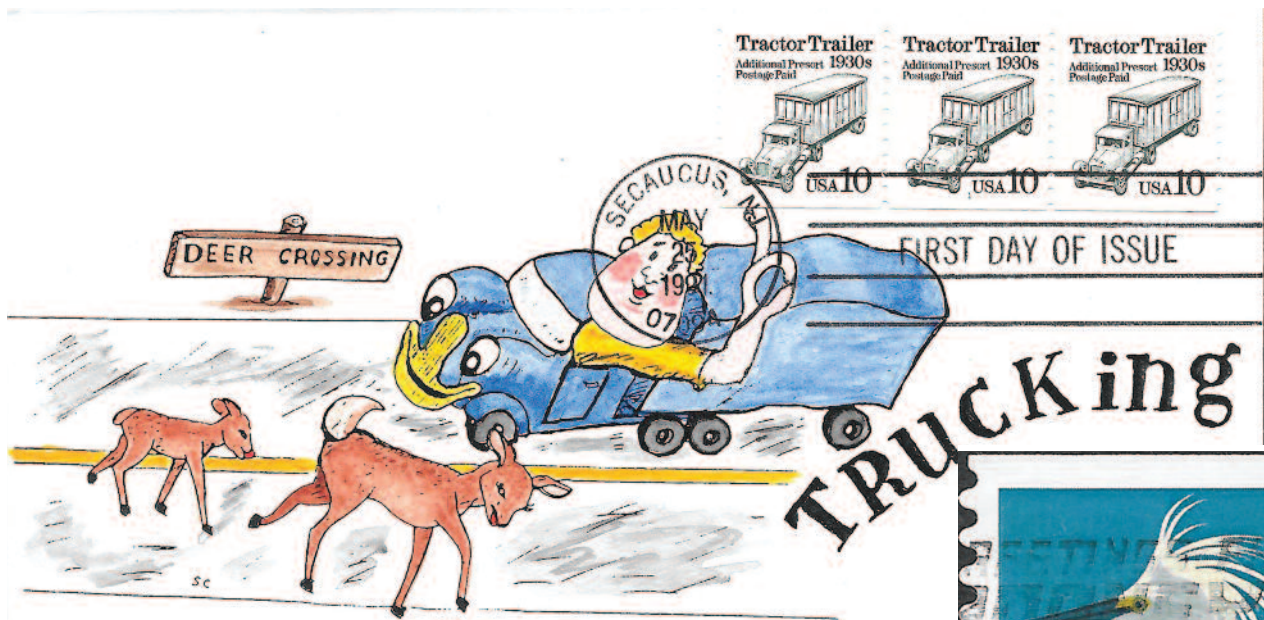

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Love Hearts: New Counterfeit Coil

Prior to 2018, I found a total of 10 different counterfeit rolls and stamps. All but two of them were from sellers on eBay. In 2018, I found a total of nine counterfeits ranging from stamps on piece and on cover from Bob Murrin; stamps from eBay including mint rolls, sheets and booklets; through covers from around the Houston area; and from prison covers that I get from time to time. However, in 2019 that number exploded to 49 different counterfeit stamps. This included tagged versions of the 2017 BCA Flag coil and the 2018 APU Flag coil, as well as three tagged types for the 2018 BCA Flag booklet.

So far in 2020 (through January 26), I have found nine more counterfeits. This article is about two of those recent finds.

The first is a 2017 Flag coil similar to the Scott 5159 APU version, but it has a date (Figure 1) along the lower-left edge of "2018." This is the first counterfeit of this issue with the wrong date that I have found. This will be referred to as 5159 CF4. The stamp is on piece that I got from Bob Murrin. The die cut measures approximately 8.3. It has very crude die cuts, with the normal vertical die cuts at the top and bottom, somewhat diagonally oriented. It does not appear to have any microprinting.

The second is for the 2019 Love Hearts Blossom sheet, Scott 5339. This will be referred to as

5339 CF2. I ordered sheets of 20 stamps from a seller on eBay. The sheets were untagged and turned out to be the second counterfeit version of this issue. The purple hearts show a checkered-dot pattern. On 5339 CF1, the purple, orange and gray hearts and letters have a checkered-dot pattern.

Along with the sheets was a strip of five

stamps in a coil format, also for the Love Hearts Blossom. These are untagged as well. The stamps measure about 29.4 mm high and 24.0 mm wide. They are small enough to have been cut from a sheet, but there are no die cuts on the back as you would expect if it was from a sheet of stamps.

The die cut measures approximately 9.1 to 9.4. The die cuts beginning at the top are smooth, then as they go down, they become uneven and then very crude, ending in vertical die cuts at the bottom, indicating an APU-style stamp. The purple hearts show a checkered-dot pattern like the 5339 CF2. The "USPS" microprinting is located below the right red heart and is close to the genuine. The backing paper is soft and porous.

ORCOEXPO Meeting Report

On Saturday, January 11, 15 PNC³ club members and guests gathered at the ORCOEXPO stamp show in Fullerton, California. The meeting was hosted by John Himes, Dan Forgues and Jeff Haas. The session kicked off with introductions by those present. It was truly amazing to hear about the specialized philatelic areas our members collect.

The attendees previewed the two upcoming stamp issues: the new Presorted Standard Star coil and the new Wild Orchids coil. There was a lot of discussion about how the Orchids will be collected, since there will be 10 different images, and most agreed that a PS11 will be the best choice due to the length of a PS21 strip.

John Himes shared some interesting new finds and encouraged everyone to look for the rarer varieties in used mixtures, as well as in mint strips.

The two newest PNC³ publications, the *6th Edition Illustrated Glossary* and the *3rd Edition Precancel Gaps Values List*, were made available for everyone to preview. Most everyone agreed that the glossary is an important addition to every PNCer's library. John pointed out that purchasing a copy of the Gaps Values List would be a great idea, too, since identifying just one of the rarer precancel strips in one's collection would more than pay the price of the publication.

The meeting wrapped up by handing out door prizes to everyone in attendance. Many thanks to PNC³ member-dealer Dave Cobb for providing some wonderful precancel gap strips for the door prize giveaway.

We hope to have another PNC³ local meeting at the SESCAL stamp show in Ontario, California, later this year.

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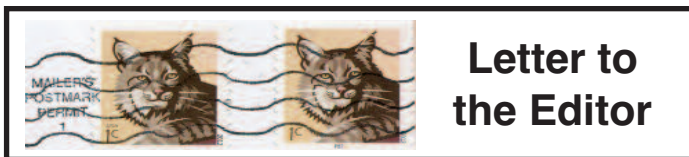
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'I Like Lists'

While it will be old news by the time you read this issue of **Coil Line**, a new plate number on the 2019 US Flag issue, B2222, was found in North Carolina in mid-January. Frank Covey reports on the find in this issue. I have subsequently found this number at my post office in New Jersey, so it's likely to be available in other locations.

As have many of you, I recently received the latest edition of *USA Philatelic*, the U.S Postal Service's catalog of stamps available for purchase. The listings for coil stamps, especially those issued for bulk mailers, are vastly improved. For example, the listings for the Fruits low value coils now include full rolls of 3,000 and 10,000 as well as strips of 500 from both versions. Listings for coils not yet issued as of publication date and for some earlier issues now include strips of 25 and 500 where available. And both printers' versions of last year's First Class Forever US Flag issue are now listed. While not all currently available bulk mail coils are included, the new catalog is a definite improvement over the last several editions.

The amendments to the club bylaws, for which a ballot was mailed to all members in the fall, have been adopted buy a vote of 218 to 1. Thanks to all members who returned their ballots. The updated bylaws have been posted on the club web site and can be found under the PNC³ Membership menu.

This is an election year for the club and candidates willing to run for office are always needed. If you are interested in becoming involved, please reach out to Nominating Committee chair Robert Thompson. Robert's contact information can be found in the masthead. Most offices do not require a major time commitment.

New Publications Available

A trio of new publications are being offered with this issue of **Coil Line**.

First are the 2020 PNC ID Lists with the 2019 New Issues added to all three indices, i.e. Name Index, Scott Number Cross Reference and the PNC ID Master List with plate numbers. Also, the "Recent PNC List" has USPS item numbers for ordering from Philatelic Fulfilment in Kansas City. Included in this list are the first new issues of 2020, i.e. the Presorted Standard Star and the Wild Orchids.

Next is the 2019 New Issues in color. A full page is devoted to the difference between the B1111 and B2222 plate numbers on the U.S. Flag 2019 from BCA (2019-2).

Lastly is a new publication titled "Forever Flags 2014-2018." Nomenclature on some pages differs from that used in the original New Issues publications to agree with new naming conventions adopted this year by the Catalog Committee. Some new images are shown.

Starting this year you can pay for these publications using PayPal. See the order form for details. The two-page order form can be found on this month's wrapper. We print enough of each publication to meet the initial demand. Orders are filled in early April.

3. For precancel strips: If has gap, it's listed; no listing=NO GAP!
4. In case of a tie bid, the earliest postmark or email date wins.
5. All winning bids will be at one bidding increment over the second high bidder.
6. I will not accept phone bids; bids must be only via mail and email! (Please submit Bid Sheet on wrapper for mail use.)
7. R = right, L = left, HVY = heavy, Lt = light, BMC = black machine cancel, PMC = purple machine cancel, FDC = 1st day cover or cancel, S# = plain strip, sh. = shoulder, RHC = red hand cancel, BHC = black hand cancel, @ = at, btm = bottom, cvr = cover, [cvr] = with window, rtn = return, Rec'd = Received, SCV = Scott Catalog Value, VAL = PNC3 Values List.

8. ALL Bids must be in the auction director's hands by the closing date **Tuesday, March 31, 2020** and not just postmarked by that date.

9. Bids not conforming to the bidding increments will be lowered according to the proper increment.

10. "Buy Bids" will be accepted, but realize that only one Buy Bid can be honored and that is the first one, and at only one advance over second high bidder.

11. IF you add a "+" (plus sign) to your bid, I will use it to break a tie only if needed.

12. Please, when placing a bid over the Internet, DO NOT use a spreadsheet or other such program as I have problems opening them. Just place it in standard email form. Flyspecking Patriotic Banners

Jim Carmack

Since retiring, I have been staggering through my significant accumulation of PNCs and covers to check for varieties. You know ... flyspecking. Let's see what the Patriotic Banners show us.

First (Figure 1) is Scott #4158 plate # S111, the non-denominated (10) Patriotic Banner printed by Sennett in 2007. There are two color varieties and this is the Royal Blue with rose-colored stripes. It is a pretty good example of a broken double die cut where the die cutting mats do not align properly. I obtained a strip of 25 from the "Cave" from a 10K roll. This was in that strip but, obviously, the only PNS5 (figures 1 and 2).

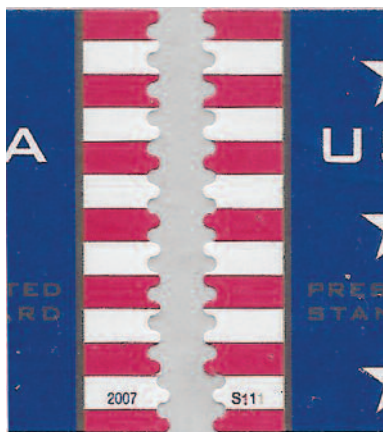

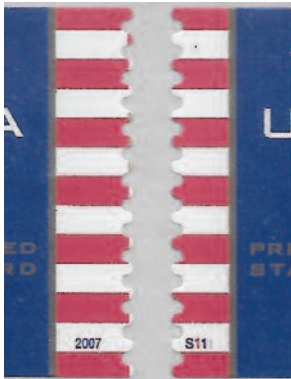

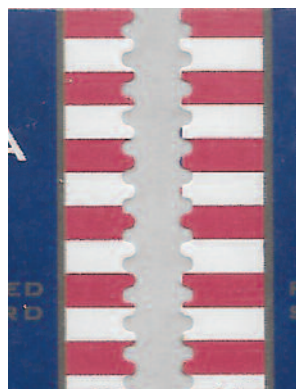

Next (figures 3 and 4) is a refresher in colored perf tips with coloration on the left side of the perf tips of the plate number stamp S111 and the right side of the stamp to the left of the plate number. The catalog states that it's believed that the

are color registration bars to the left of the plate numbered stamp that were supposed to be cut out when die cut.

Finally, we have faint-colored perf tips (Figure 5) on #4157,

plate # V333 printed by Avery Dennison on cover which I don't see mentioned in the 2017 value guide or the PNC³ catalog. The cover was sent by the Pfizer company and contents (dated) were maintained. Presumably, the reasoning is the same as on #4158 but to a lesser degree.
